

Fees information for applicants to the 2019/2020 school year

School, boarding and other compulsory costs outlined in this document reflect the 2018/2019 school year, and will change. All fees are quoted in Singapore dollars and include 7% Goods and Services Tax (GST), where applicable. GST is subject to change.

Information on fees that apply to a small number of students, for example Learning Support, English as an Additional Language, Home Language (Mother Tongue) programme or optional trips, are available from Admissions. Bus fees are set by the bus provider and are invoiced directly by them – an indicative schedule can be found on our website.

- One off, non-refundable charges per student; there is no deposit payable.
- Application fees are payable at the time of application; we accept American Express, MasterCard or Visa.
- For families making application for three or more children for August 2019 entry, the Enrolment fee (upon successful application) will be discounted as follows: 25% reduction for the third child; 50% reduction for the fourth and subsequent children.

- Fees are invoiced in advance of each term; there are three terms each year and fees are billed in three equal parts.

Boarders in Grades 8–10 are required to commit to a full year in the boarding house. Grade 11 entrants are required to commit to stay in the boarding house until the completion of the two-year IB Diploma Programme.

Fee payment options

Application fees must be paid online with American Express, MasterCard or Visa during the application process.

Enrolment and term fees are invoiced to parents on acceptance of a place, and parents are then billed termly (see below for details on billing cycle). Payment options for enrolment and term fees include:^{1,2}

Billing cycle for fees

Fees are payable in advance and are billed on a termly basis as follows:

- Term 1 fees are payable before the end of Term 2 of the previous school year
- Term 2 fees are payable at the start of Term 1
- Term 3 fees are payable before the end of Term 1

*The withdrawal deadline is the date by which payment must be received to secure continued enrolment into the invoiced term; or online notice of withdrawal must be submitted to secure a refund of fees already paid. Students are considered withdrawn at the end of term if fees are not received by this 'notification of withdrawal deadline' which is also published each year on the College website and in the weekly eBrief newsletter sent to all parents.
